

MILESTONES | Tarlac Agricultural University (TAU) is now a member of the United Nations Academic Impact (UNAI)

Mr. Robert Skinner, Deputy Director and Chief of Partnerships and Global Engagement at the UN, welcomed TAU by awarding the acceptance certificate on 5 July as the newest UNAI official cohort.

As part of a diverse community of 1,600 institutions across 152 countries that collaborate with the UN to advance global objectives, such as peace, human rights, and sustainable development, TAU is mandated to undertake at least one initiative aligned with UNAI's ten principles within a given calendar year.

Including TAU, Ateneo School of Government, Southeast Asia Interdisciplinary Development Institute (SAIDI), University of Santo Tomas (UST), and University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB), there are currently 15 UNAI member-organizations in the Philippines.

In a clear display of its dedication to championing the endeavors of the UN, the External Linkages and International Affairs (ELIA), with the support of Dr. Max P. Guillermo, TAU President, worked on the institutional application early this year.
