(2) **Government-funded scholarships** are funded by various government agencies duly established partnerships with the university to provide assistance to deserving students. (3) **Private-funded scholarship programs** are funded by private individuals, organizations and companies seeking to provide educational assistance to deserving students. Each is supported by signed and notarized memoranda of agreement.
