2. Increase awareness of issues affecting LGBTQI+, PWD, ID, solo parents, and international students, especially among the student leaders of TAU


3. To help TAU student organizations integrate concepts of inclusion into their programs and activities.


4. To foster bonds and create camaraderie among students, faculty, and staff at TAU




