



The Tarlac Agricultural University — College of Education, serving as the Regional Global Citizenship Education (GCED) Hub of Region III, successfully conducted a free two-day virtual seminar and research colloquium titled "Fostering Global Perspectives: Integrating Global Citizenship Education into Curriculum and Research Practices" on April 18–19, 2024, via Zoom. The activity aimed to introduce participants to the principles and applications of Global Citizenship Education (GCED) in the areas of curriculum development, foundational concepts, and research practices. It was attended by 124 teacher educators, school heads and administrators, and graduate teacher-education students from the Philippines, Indonesia, and Thailand. The first day featured insightful lectures from Mr. Vishaesh Juvvadi, a US Peace Corps Volunteer; Prof. Carl Dellomos of the Philippine Normal University; and Mr. Christian Pavik, a US Peace Corps Response Volunteer. The second day highlighted the research colloquium proper, which provided a platform for teaching professionals and pre-service teachers to share their research studies and engage in scholarly exchange on GCED-related themes.
