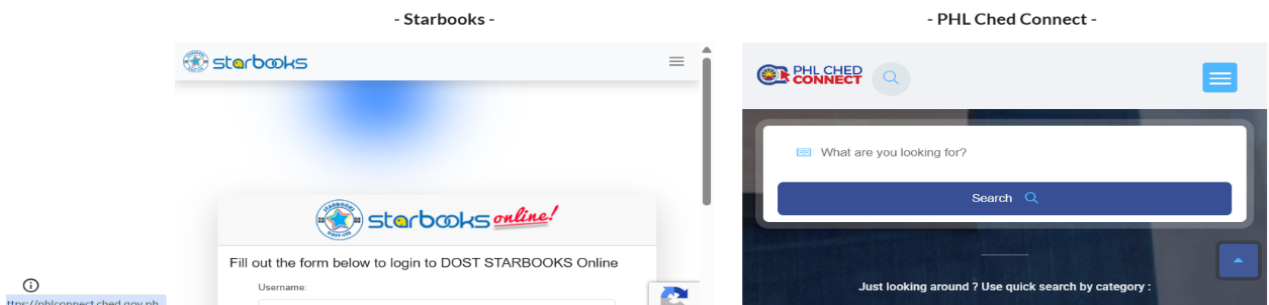
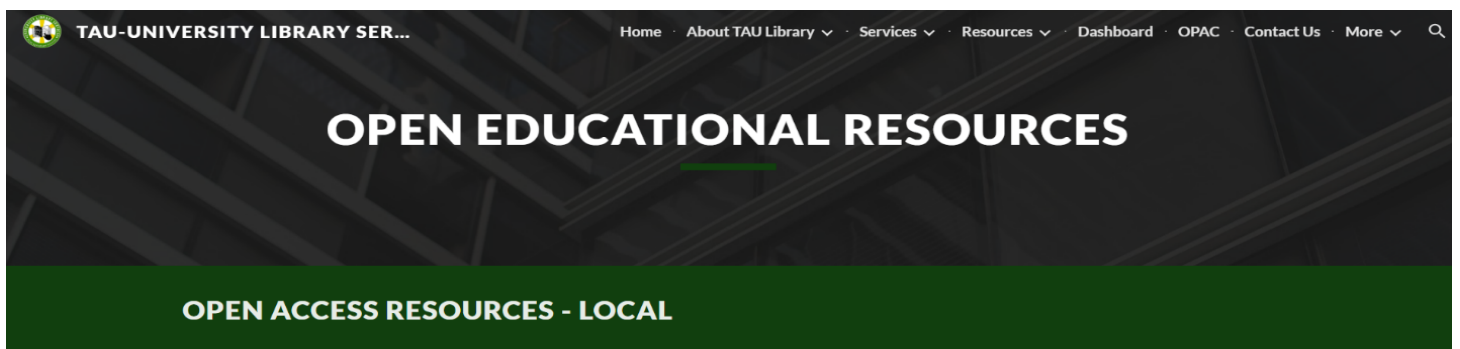


TAU Library Online Resources

Tarlac Agricultural University through the university library offers various online resources that are freely accessible to all its stakeholders – students, faculty, staff, alumni, including outside researchers. The subscribed databases consisting of eBooks and e-Journals can be accessed by the academic community by requesting the username and password of the databases. There are also curated open access online resources which can be accessed freely by students and faculty including the general public. These resources are designed to enhance learning and research activities by offering convenient, barrier-free access anytime and anywhere, thereby reinforcing TAU's commitment to open and inclusive knowledge dissemination. They can be easily accessed through the library's website and online public access catalog (OPAC).
